# May: Praying the Rosary: During the month of May, Catholics pray the Rosary.





The Church has used three sets of mysteries for many centuries. In 2002 Pope John Paul II proposed a fourth set of mysteries—the Mysteries of Light, or Luminous Mysteries. According to his suggestion, the four sets of mysteries might be prayed on the following days: the Joyful Mysteries on Monday and Saturday, the Sorrowful Mysteries on Tuesday and Friday, the Glorious Mysteries on Wednesday and Sunday, and the Luminous Mysteries on Thursday.

### The Joyful Mysteries

- **1. The Annunciation:** Mary learns that she has been chosen to be the mother of Jesus.
- **2. The Visitation:** Mary visits Elizabeth, who tells her that she will always be remembered.
- 3. The Nativity: Jesus is born in a stable in Bethlehem.
- **4. The Presentation:** Mary and Joseph take the infant Jesus to the Temple to present him to God.
- **5. The Finding of Jesus in the Temple:** Jesus is found in the Temple discussing his faith with the teachers.

#### The Mysteries of Light

- **1. The Baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan:** God proclaims that Jesus is his beloved Son.
- 2. The Wedding Feast at Cana: At Mary's request, Jesus performs his first miracle.
- **3.** The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God: Jesus calls all to conversion and service to the Kingdom.
- **4.** The Transfiguration of Jesus: Jesus is revealed in glory to Peter, James, and John.
- **5. The Institution of the Eucharist:** Jesus offers his Body and Blood at the Last Supper.

#### The Sorrowful Mysteries

- The Agony in the Garden: Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane on the night before he dies.
- The Scourging at the Pillar: Jesus is lashed with whips.
- **3.** The Crowning With Thorns: Jesus is mocked and crowned with thorns.
- 4. The Carrying of the Cross: Jesus carries the cross that will be used to crucify him.
- 5. The Crucifixion: Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies.

#### The Glorious Mysteries

- The Resurrection: God the Father raises Jesus from the dead.
- 2. The Ascension: Jesus returns to his Father in heaven.
- **3.** The Coming of the Holy Spirit: The Holy Spirit comes to bring new life to the disciples.
- **4.** The Assumption of Mary: At the end of her life on earth, Mary is taken body and soul into heaven.
- The Coronation of Mary: Mary is crowned as Queen of Heaven and Earth.

#### **School uniform**

# **ADMINISTRATION OF SCHOOLS (AOS)**

Catholic Education Western Australia (CEWA) has committed to a new Administration software platform that has been a work in progress for the last couple of years.

As the demands of modern schools increase, the services required to support schools increase faster still. AoS (Admin of Schools) is a comprehensive engine designed to integrate all of these services and unite them in one central management system. St Lawrence's have been working with staff from CEWA in preparation for the installation of AoS, to replace our current Administration system.

Please be aware that this will occur as of 01 June 2020. There will be several changes such as a new BPAY reference number and SEQTA logins.

We will send you a Fee Statement showing your current balance and updated payment details in the coming weeks. Please take note of your new BPAY reference number on the attached Fee Statement. Prior to making any BPAY payments, please update your bank account details to the new BPAY reference number.

We will send Parents/Carers a link to setup their accounts. All families are required to setup their new account within a week of receiving the link in order to access past reports. Please ensure you keep your username and password, in order to use this again at the end of the year.
