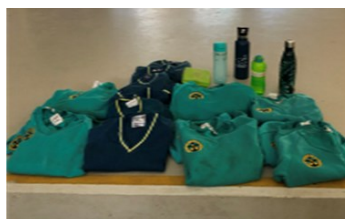

**Please Note:** Individuals and Family Photos are not available to view online

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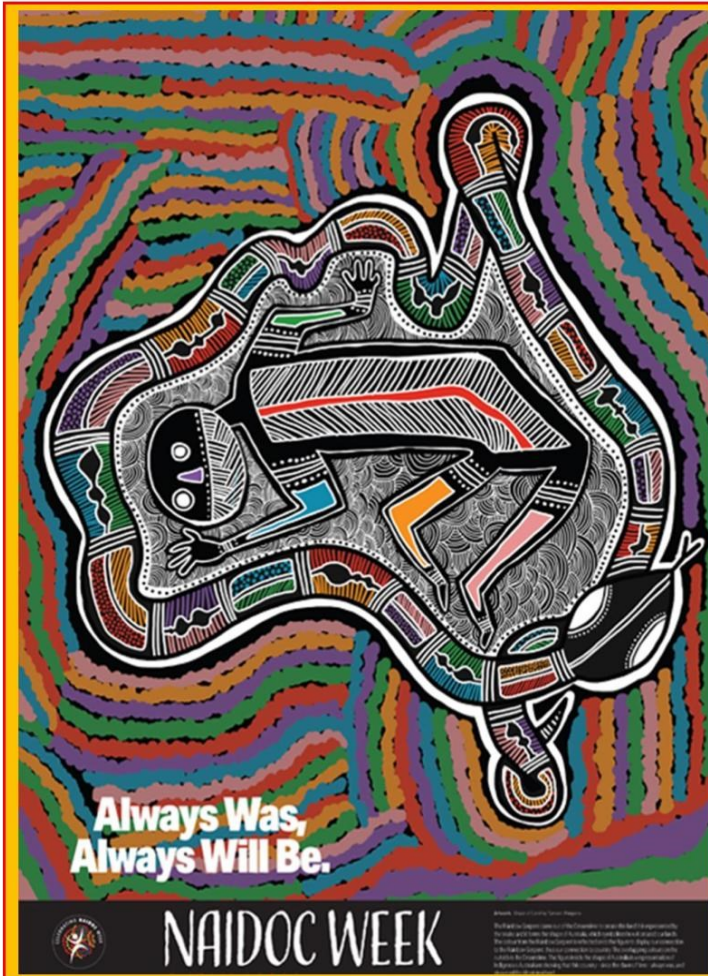




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## NAIDOC Week 2020
